




We have six **Marie Curie Studentships** available to EU (non-UK) students for research on the generic factors driving **chronic inflammation** in different tissues. Three of the studentships are for 3 years and will lead to a PhD. Three other studentships are for 1 year and can lead to a masters degree, or can act as stand alone training fellowships in chronic inflammation.

The generously funded fellowships begin in July 2006. Application deadline: March 10th 2006. A further three 3 year fellowships will be available July 2007 with an application deadline of March 2007.
