The history of the wheelchair basketball

- Developed in US during WW2

(participant athletes were professional basketball players but after the WW2 they became disabled veterans)

- Meanwhile in Stoke Mandeville the wheelchair basketball was the equipment of the locomotor rehabilitation for the veteran soldiers

(Remarkable: on the first championship paraathletes played without shutter (it was called netball)

- Wheelchair basketball sport appeared in 1960 in Rome on the 1st Paralimpic Games (the exclusion criteria of the paraathletes was the ability to run or skip)

-Present times in Hungary, National Rehabilitation Center in Budapest: wheelchair basketball is the part of rehabilitation for the amputated people and for those who suffered spinal cord injury

- Autumn 2016: 1st Hungarian International Basketball Championship was held in Pécs



The rules of the wheelchair basketball

Kerekesszékes kosárlabda szabályai

- Rules follow the National Basket Society(FIBA) rules of the game
- 4x10 min, 2x5 paraathletes, 1-2-3 point,
- the size of the ball, and height of the ring are the same , no restart,
 step mistake means: player touches the wheel of the chair more than twice without retrieving the basketball,)
- Chair, pillow height



Classification

- 1-4,5 point
- Most of the wheelchair basketball paraathletes have proper anatomical and functional upper extremities, and properly working chest musculatory system except from the players with spinal cord injuries
- Paraathletes have various trunk controll and sitting balance influencing their ability of catching and throwing the ball
- max. five players of the team are allowed to stay on the field at the same time, the total score of the team: max.
 14 points
